Next Wednesday is Ash Wednesday and the beginning of Lent. During this holy season, the Church asks us to give more attention to personal prayer, self-sacrifice, and helping the poor. Here in St. Joseph's, the annual Lenten Project is our way of helping people in need. We are very aware of the many people who are suffering all over the world, especially the most vulnerable, the elderly, women and small children. This year we propose to renew our help to the suffering people of Haiti and Ukraine.
