### CRUCIFIED AND RISEN

The Risen Lord showed his wounds to his disciples. He still carries those wounds as an abiding reminder of the suffering that continues to afflict the world.

“Ours were the sufferings he bore”, Jesus’ wounds are the wounds of a suffering humanity. When we look at Jesus on the cross he wants us to see not just his wounds but the wounds of all suffering people. The joy of the Resurrection should never obscure the sad reality of a suffering world but rather empower us to bring the good news of God’s compassionate love to all suffering people.
