DILEXIT NOS: HE LOVED US



Pope Francis's new encyclical Dilexit Nos (24 October), 2024, is a meditation of the heart of Jesus, the heart of the Gospel. It is an appeal to all people to return to the heart as the fountain of tender love.

The whole of Jesus life and mission, as it were, flows from a heart filled with the love of God. It is from the heart of Jesus that his words of comfort and encouragement come, it is from his heart that the acts and gestures of healing and forgiveness come, it is from his heart that the willingness to lay down his life for us comes.

Pope Francis invites us to return to our own hearts that have been touched by the love of Jesus and to become "people of heart" in a world so torn and divided by the clash of ideologies, by the love of money, and the drive for power. It is only with the energy of the heart that the many troubles of humanity can be touched, healed and transformed.

The pope says that devotion to the Sacred Heart can help to awaken our hearts, remind us of the depths and extent of God's love, and inspire us to bring both the fire and the consolation of love into the lives of the people we meet.
