LENTEN PROJECT 2025



Lent begins this week on Ash Wednesday 5 March. As usual, St. Joseph's will have a Lenten Project to collect funds to help people who are struggling in different parts of the world. This year we will be helping the work of the Passionists in Vietnam and the people of Goma in Congo. We have helped the Vietnamese Passionists before when they began their mission. We are happy to do so again.

As you may have heard, last month Congolese rebels, assisted by foreign troops, captured the city of Goma. They killed thousands of the inhabitants and displaced many more thousands. The displaced people have no secure access to food or water. They are struggling to survive. The Xaverian Missionaries are doing their best to find basic foods and other necessities for the people. They have asked for our help. This year's Lenten Project is our way of helping them.

The Lenten Project is one important way of fulfilling the spirit of Lent that calls for prayer, fasting and alms giving. I encourage all the parishioners to find the most suitable ways of entering into this holy season of preparation for Easter. It is a very good practice to attend daily Mass during Lent. There is Mass at St. Joseph's every weekday at 8.30 am; 11 am on Saturdays. Every Friday during Lent there will be Mass at 7.30 pm followed by the Stations of the Cross.

We pray for God's blessing on everyone who will come to our Church during Lent and remember in a special way the suffering people of Congo and Vietnam.
