The fall of the city of Bukavu into the hands of the rebel group "M23" and the "Congo River Alliance", Sunday, February 16, 2025, marks the beginning of a long night of uncertainty and suffering"*



In Vietnam: building a Passionist centre:

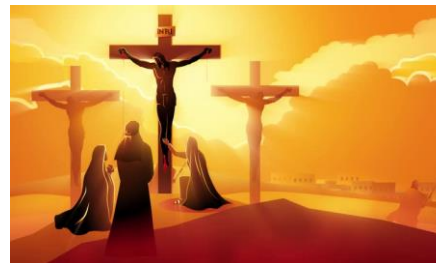
