Extract from this Sunday's FHC booklet 2025: AND THIS IS ONLY THE BEGINNING....

.../... Our catechism tells us that all seven of the Sacraments were instituted by Jesus Himself and that they "bear fruit in those who receive them" with reverence. This is quite a thought, isn't it? God makes Jesus really present in the bread and wine through the action of the Holy Spirit. How He does this we do not know, but we do know that since the Last Supper, first written down by Saint Paul in the Second Reading in the years after the Resurrection of Jesus, the Church believes and teaches that its founder Jesus is "really present" in this way at each Mass. This also means that those who have made their First Holy Communion are part of God's plan in an even closer way than they were when they received Baptism! .../...
