THE EXALTATION OF THE HOLY CROSS



The feast of the Exaltation of the Cross celebrates God's victory over every form of sin, suffering and death. Jesus shared our humanity and even the terrible pain and suffering of death. We believe that he stays close to us in our daily struggles and helps us with his healing and saving power.

Like so many others, Jesus was publicly humiliated and executed for crimes he did not commit. In the cross is displayed the harsh cruelty and injustice that brings so much suffering into the world.

But Jesus transforms this symbol of inhumanity into the symbol of God's saving love. Where human cruelty and ugliness Is at its worse, God appears with compassion and mercy.

For Christians, the Cross is the abiding reminder that God stands with us in our trials and sufferings. The Cross proclaims the victory of life over death, of goodness over evil, and of love over hatred once and for all and forever.

It is the mission of the Passionists to keep alive the memory of the Passion and death of Jesus as the greatest manifestation and proof of God's saving love. We pray that the memory of the cross and passion will inflame the hearts of all Christians with an abiding love and gratitude for God.
