The new Parish Priest of St. Joseph's is **Father Kieran Creagh**. He will arrive in Parish on Wednesday September 24.

Fr. Kieran is a an Irish Passionist, born in Belfast in 1963 and grew up in the Passionist parish of Holy Cross, Ardoyne. He is a cradle Passionist!

Kieran spent formative years as a missionary in South Africa where he was parish Priest of St. George's Parish, Saulsville, Pretoria. At the height of the Aids crisis, he founded Leratong, a hospice for the terminally ill. There, one night, he was the victim of a robbery and shooting and almost lost his life. Kieran is still very committed to Leratong and works hard to find the support to keep it going.

Kieran comes to us from Sacred Heart parish in Belfast. While there he has contributed greatly to the renewal of the parish and he will be greatly missed by the people.

Father Kieran will bring a fresh pair of eyes as well as energy and creativity to St. Joseph's. Let's give him a warm welcome and assure him of our prayers, collaboration and support.
