**Leratong Hospice** is an **18 bedded in patient** offering holistic pall active care to all its patients and necessary support to their families

**Hospice Mission:** Excellence providing holistic palliative care for patients and support for their families and actively promoting palliative care in the community of Atteridgeville, Saulsville, the surrounding informal settlements, Lotus gardens, Pretoria west, Laudium, and neighbouring communities.

**Hospice Objectives:** To ensure quality holistic palliative care and support for patients and families faced with life threatening illness such as: HIV AIDS; Cancer; Tuberculosis.

Management of uncontrolled physical and emotional symptoms and also 2 weeks respite care for the chronically ill patients, to give the family a break from their day to day caring of their loved one, whilst seeking for alternative long term placement.

Nutritional support to patients to supplement the medication and treatment.

To promote holistic palliative care through mentorship, training and engagement with the community and relevant stakeholders.

To maintain Leratong accreditation by Council of Health Services Accreditation of Southern Africa.

To ensure sustainability of Leratong through excellence in governance, leadership and management and service.
