Bric-a-Brac Stall - Donations Needed

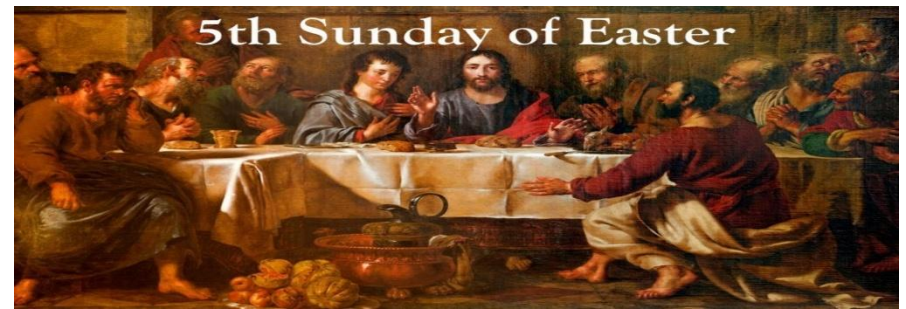
We would be very grateful for donations of good-quality bric-a-brac for our parish stall. Items should be clean, in good condition and suitable for resale.
